VEGETATION DROP OFF: Wednesday & Saturday 8:00 to 12:00 at maintenance barn on Coral Gables. **DO NOT DROP ANYTHING EXCEPT VEGETATION IN THIS AREA!**

HEAVY TRASH DROP OFF AT MAINTAINANCE BARN: WED/SEPT 4 & SAT/SEPT 7 8:00-12:00 (ALWAYS 1ST WED OF THE MONTH AND FOLLOWING SAT)
